The Enrollment specialist will educate consumers about their health insurance options and assist them throughout all phases of the application process for the plan that best suits their needs. The specialist will also conduct extensive outreach and education for consumers who are eligible for coverage under the Affordable Care Act.

**Program:** LawNY® is a not-for-profit law firm which provides civil legal services to low-income clients in a 14-county region in western New York State. The office provides legal advice and representation in the areas of housing, foreclosure defense, public benefits, family, employment and consumer law. Program staff includes attorneys and paralegals who work across areas of specialization to bring a holistic approach to addressing issues affecting our clients and communities. LawNY® focuses on meeting the legal needs of individual clients, as well as

addressing systemic problems that create barriers for clients living in poverty.

**Requirements:** The Enrollment Specialist must demonstrate maturity, strong interpersonal skills, and the ability to communicate with and educate consumers. Above all, candidates for the position must have a strong dedication to the principle that everyone should have access to quality health care coverage no matter what their economic or social circumstances. Access to transportation and availability during some evenings and weekends is a requirement. Fluency in another language, such as Spanish, is a plus, but not a requirement.

**Salary:** Salary is dependent on experience. The entry-level annual salary for a paralegal is \$30,000 and increases to \$35,000 for a paralegal with five years of experience.
